St. John the Evangelist Twinning Request

St. John the Evangelist in San Marcos is one of the Conferences deeply impacted by the Memorial Day Floods. To date, the Conference has provided an incredible \$12,422 in direct assistance to flood victims.

The Diocesan Council will reimburse St John the Evangelist Conference \$12,422 from the Disaster Relief Fund.

However, as St. John the Evangelist continues to provide assistance through the always difficult summer, the Conference anticipates a shortfall of \$4,019 for each of the next three months. In July, this shortfall was covered by the balance from the previous month.

As the Conference anticipates the same donation figures from the parish and Our Lady of Wisdom for the months of August, September and October, St. John the Evangelist is seeking twinning assistance from any conference or district that may be able to help. The Conference anticipates a 10% increase in regular bill requests due to higher than normal utility usage.

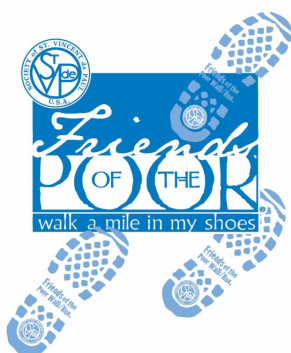

A Reflection from our Board President

Summer always proves to be a challenging time for most conferences. The demand for food goes up significantly, electric and water bills are at their peak, and the need for rent never seems to go away. To top all this off, collections are often lower than normal because families are traveling, school is out, and back to school expenses are on the horizon.

I am reading Pope Francis' book *The Joy of the Gospel*, and there is a quote I read recently that I want to share. I couldn't help think about the hundreds of people we serve daily and the amount of money we have been blessed with to give away. It is always a challenge to know how much to help? Are we doing the right thing? Is this really going to make a difference? Or are we just putting a band-aid on the situation?

In *The Joy of the Gospel*, Pope Francis says, "Not to share one's wealth with the poor is to steal from them and to take away their livelihood. It is not our own goods which we hold, but theirs. Money must serve, not rule!"

Listening to Relevant radio, I heard two things that stuck with me that also relate to the ministry of serving those in need:

- To be a saint, we have to do ordinary things in an extraordinary way
- Listen with the ear of the heart

I don't think we can be good Vincentians without either of these, and we do a very good job at both. Remember this the next time you question yourself: listen with your heart, do the extraordinary and never forget money must serve, not rule!
